Armory/Senior Center Status

What we wanted in March 2015!





"Senior Center/Armory building will be vacated in

2016, when the seniors move to their new space by the Recreation Center

Our proposal: convert it into an Arts and Cultural Center:

- 1. Performances and Events
 - 3rd floor is a perfectly suited large event space.
 - 1st floor has commercial kitchen
- 2. Office space and shared services for individuals and organizations
 - The 2nd floor is perfectly suited for this, as currently configured, on either for part-time or full-time users
- 3. Meeting, smaller events, limited gallery, and some studio space.
 - 1st and 2nd floors have spaces configurable to these needs"

What has happened in 2016!



As the Senior Center project moved ahead, the City released an RFP in 2015 with:

 proposals due 3/31/2016 for the use, or purchase, of the old Senior Center/Armory building

The Rochester Arts and Cultural Collaborative (RACC) has done the following:

- formed the Art and Cultural Initiative (ACI) corporation
- submitted an ACI proposal to the City to use the old Senior Center/Armory building as an arts and cultural community space

Key ACI Proposal Content



From ACI's incorporation documents:

 "Arts & Cultural Initiative (ACI) Mission/Purpose: To create, facilitate and manage affordable and collaborative spaces and services for arts and cultural initiatives."

From the ACI Proposal to the City of Rochester:

- "The proposed vision is for a vibrant, multi-use facility which will serve both:
 - the arts community (of all types), and
 - the diverse cultural communities of Rochester."

ACI's Argument



The old Senior Center/Armory building is perfectly suited for arts and cultural needs:

- large performance space
- large and small galleries
- classroom and meeting spaces
- office and studio spaces, and
- a commercial kitchen

All of the above make a perfect configuration for a community-based arts and cultural facility.

• The fact that it is an historic building and aesthetically pleasing only adds to the allure.

ACI Proposal Funding Model



Program operations will be supported by:

- rental of space for galleries, studios and offices
- fees for performances, cultural events, meetings, and other programmatic activities
- grants
- donations and fundraising
- non-programmatic events (e.g. weddings)

Building costs have been requested through:

• a City subsidy for building upkeep and utilities
