- Encourage use of bike trails


Art4Trails and RACC



- February 9: Park Department permitted the sites and sculptures
- February 25: Artists received \$1000 for materials and supplies
- June: Artists install sculptures and receive an additional \$1000 for their work

Park Permit and Artists Payments

- Art will stay in place 3 months to a year
- Art remains the property of the artist
- Artists may sell the art during Art4Trails
- The City may decide to purchase the art and retain it in place
- Richard Brubaker has donated his sculpture to the City, so it will remain permanently
